

UriMEX Basics Course Bern 27-28 March 2026



We invite you to the Urine Sediment Course, tailored for nephrology trainees and interested medical professionals. This course provides essential knowledge and skills for evaluating urine sediments, a key aspect of nephrology diagnostics. Participants will learn both the methodology and the necessary background related to patient information and clinical context. Understanding urine sediment analysis requires not only familiarity with the methodology but also a solid foundation of background knowledge encompassing patient information, clinical context, and nephrology. Hence, this course covers not only the theory and techniques of urine sample collection and examination but also delves into the most prevalent clinical nephrological conditions.

Developed with Dr. Fogazzi, a leading expert in urine sediment analysis, this course combines theory with practical experience. Each theoretical segment is followed by hands-on sessions, allowing participants to examine urine sediments with their own microscopes. The same samples will then be analyzed collectively using video microscopy, guided by Dr. Fogazzi.
